Under the Aazadi Amrit Mohatsav umbrella programme and as part of the Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat, an intercultural exchange was held between the Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow and North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong on 7th March 2022 on the theme **Indigenous Cuisine**. The online programme featured presentations cum demonstrations of select indigenous cuisine of Uttar Pradesh and Meghalaya.

The programme was introduced by Professor Naveen Arora, Nodal Officer of EBSB, BBA University, Lucknow who also gave an account of the activities undertaken by BBA university under EBSB.
