

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT RULES, 2016

DUTIES OF WASTE GENERATOR

1. Segregate and store the waste generated by them in three separate streams namely **bio-degradable**, **non-bio-degradable** and **domestic hazardous** wastes in suitable bins.



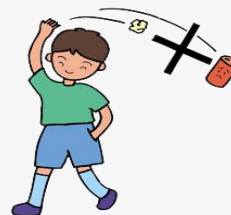
4. Wrap securely the used **sanitary waste** like diapers, sanitary pads etc., in the pouches provided by the manufacturers or brand owners of these products or in a suitable wrapping material as instructed by the local authorities and shall place the same in the bin meant for dry waste or non-bio degradable waste.

2. Store **construction and demolition waste** separately, as and when generated, in his own premises and dispose off as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016.



5. Store **horticulture waste** and garden waste generated from his premises separately in his own premises and dispose of as per the directions of the local body from time to time.

3. **No waste generator shall throw, burn or bury** the solid waste generated by him, on streets, open public spaces outside his premises or in the drain or water bodies.



E-Waste including electronic devices and electrical appliances should not be mixed with the other solid waste due to the hazardous components inside them. They can be recycled again.
