WALK IN INTERVIEW FOR GUEST FACULTY POST

A walk-in-interview for the post of 3 guest lecturers in the department of the Journalism & Mass Communication, NEHU, Shillong for teaching in the February – May 2020 semester, will be held on 3rd March 2020 at 10:30 am at the office of the Dean of the School of Technology.

Interested eligible candidates may attend the interview as per above mentioned schedule with all their original certificates / mark sheets (starting from class 10/Matric onwards) with an attested photo copy of each of it and a recent passport size photograph along with the updated Bio-data.

Essential Qualification:

- 1. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- 2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (1) and (2) above, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.

Desirable areas of specialisation/interest:

1. Radio Production 2. Media Law and Ethics 3. Media Management

Note:

- 1. The remuneration would be Rs. 1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- per month.
- 2. The candidates should reach the venue of the interview by 9:30 am.
- 3. The candidates appearing for the interview will not be given TA/DA.
- 4. Candidates are advised to check the University website nehu.ac.in for interview notification and all updates thereafter. The Department will not be responsible for any other form of communication to the applicants/candidates.
