About NEHU

The North-Eastern Hill University is a premier academic institution and the oldest central university in the North-Eastern region. The North-Eastern Hill University Act (24 of 1973) passed by both Houses of Parliament received the assent of the President of India on May 26th, 1973. It was published in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary) on May 26th, 1973 together with the First Schedule of the Act incorporating the Statutes of the University. Over the years NEHU has established itself as an institution of higher learning and research of very high quality. It has been able to attract persons of proven academic excellence from almost all parts of the country to serve in its faculty; and its student community is drawn not only from the different parts of North-East but also from other parts of the country. In February 1996, the University set up a campus at Tura with the Departments of English, Garo and Education. Department of Rural Development and Agricultural Production and Department of Management started in the year 2002 and 2006 respectively. Very recently Department of Agri-Business Management & Food Technology, Department of Computer Applications, Department of History & Archaeology and Department of Horticulture have been added to the existing five departments at Tura Campus. The fulfilment of its "global" responsibilities, as a member of the global academic community, is evident from the number of research publications by its teachers in journals of high international repute and the national and international seminars and conferences which are a regular feature of the University's academic life. Our students have done well in life after leaving the University. Many have been taken into the Central Civil Services, Banking Services and into the University System. Several have been awarded scholarships and fellowships by both national and foreign organisations. The percentage of our students clearing the NET, GATE and other national tests is quite high. In a short span NEHU has matured into an institution with a serious academic and social and cultural agenda and a clear vision for its future growth.

SASNET-FF - Swedish South Asian Network for Fermented Foods

SASNET-FF - Swedish South Asian Network for Fermented Foods was established in November 2003 and is registered as a scientific society in India. It is an association of researchers, professionals, academicians, food industry personnel and all those who are interested in research, development and promotion of fermented foods especially for public health and social well-being. At the present the network has about 350 members. Initially support, advice and encouragement from late Dr. V. Kurien and Dr M S Swaminathan, were of great importance for the development of the network. At present Dr A.K. Srivastava, Ex-Vice Chancellor and Director, National Dairy Research Institute, Karnal and Prof. M C Varshneya, Ex-Vice Chancellor, Anand Agricultural University, Anand are in the Advisory Committee. The objectives of the network are: to develop a forum for scientists for exchanging information in the field of food fermentation; to promote collaborative research programmes among scientists of Europe and South Asian countries and also to collaborate with food industries in product development and marketing of fermented foods. The has network coordinated two EU sponsored projects on fermented foods and conducted strategic meetings and workshops for Directors and policy makers of R & D institutions, Managing Directors of dairy and foods industries as well as Journalists of the press and media and Social workers to spread the scientific information about the place of fermented foods in the daily diet of the people. Till now the network have organized eight international conferences, five regional conferences and several strategic meetings. It has actively facilitated joint educational and research programs between Lund University and AAU through exchange of students and collaborative research projects. SASNET Fermented Foods is also active in the field of knowledge management and the seventh volume of the International Journal of Fermented Foods was published by the network this year. &

International Academy of Physical Sciences (IAPS)

IAPS was a dream of a group of scientists working in different fields of physical sciences. In view of the growth of scientific-technological knowledge and the experiences of its application for the betterment of human society; they realized that it would be increasingly difficult to draw a dividing line to sharply differentiate between the various branches of Physical Sciences. Keeping this fact in view they decided to form a common platform for interactive discussions and interdisciplinary approaches among the scientists involved in the pursuit of knowledge in different subjects. International Academy of Physical Sciences was founded with its headquarters at Allahabad on December 4, 1994, to meet the above goals and objectives. This culminated into a foundation conference in which several scientists from different streams deliberated on interdisciplinary approaches towards conflict resolution for world problems. The Academy is conceived as a scientific body incorporating various branches of Physical, Mathematical, and Earth Sciences such as Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Geology, Geophysics and Geography, Computer Science, Informatics, Biochemistry, Biophysics, etc. The IAPS is a scientific organization of recent origin but it has already made its mark by involving in it through membership, fellowship, and activities, a large number of scientists of India and abroad, and its publications are helping in the expansion of scientific knowledge.

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
