ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU) was established on July 19, 1973, to advance knowledge and improve conditions in the North-Eastern region of India. It has three campuses: Shillong, Tura, and Wahiajer. NEHU is known for academic excellence with 406 faculty members and a diverse student body. CALL FOR PAPERS

- Interested candidates are requested to submit papers on a topic that aligns with the theme of the Seminar.
- The themes provided above are suggestive and not exhaustive, you are at liberty to go beyond the list of themes provided above as long as your paper is within the broad confines of the Seminar's topic and objectives.
- To participate in the seminar as a presenter, you must submit an abstract of not more than 300 words before **15th October, 2024.**
- If your abstract and topic are selected for presentation, you will be intimated by **16th October, 2024.**
- The abstract must be submitted through the **QR Code** containing the registration link on the last page of this brochure. No other means of submission will be entertained.
- The abstract must contain the details of the author/authors. Co-authorship of a maximum of **two authors** is allowed. The name, designation, and affiliation must be mentioned at the top right corner of the paper following the title.
- The abstract must be submitted in **Times New Roman font size 12**. The title of the paper must be in capital and bold, with the font size being 14.
- The deadline for submitting the final paper is **20th November**. It should be between **4000-5000 words**. Papers selected after a blind peer review process will be published in an edited book.
- The citation format to be used for the final paper is **ILI**.
- Abstracts and papers with more than **15%** similarity index or **5%** AI contribution will be summarily rejected.
