The Department Of JMC Organized A One Day Capacity Building Workshop



Date: 29th November, 2023: The department of Journalism and Mass Communication organized a one day capacity building workshop on intergrating social and behavior change modules into Higher Educational Institutions' Curricula with The Social and Behavior Change (SBC) Secretariat office under the aegis of Assam Don Bosco University and UNICEF Assam & Northeast in collaboration with North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU), conducting the program.

Senior Professor S. N. Sungoh, Department of Education NEHU, in her speech, encouraged the convergence of mind in committing to positive change, for the betterment of society and utilizing the power of communication to shape social and behavioral change.

Professor B. Mishra, Dean in charge, Department of Economics, NEHU, highlighted that society is tied with imaginary ropes acting as restrictions that do not exist. Appreciating the timing of the workshop as NEHU has just implemented the NEP 2020 he further added the importance of implementing the SBC in the curriculum. He emphasized SBC as the strategic use of communication approach to promoting change in knowledge, attitude, norms, beliefs, and behavior.



Further, Suresh Pramar, SBC Specialist, UNICEF Assam, and Northeast, shared his experience in implementing the modules, he also highlighted the role of communication strategies in bringing positive social and behavioral changes.

The program was graced by Prof. Aparna Khanna, Lady Irwin College, University of Delhi as the resource person. Lecture Series By The Department Of Environmental Studies, NEHU, Shillong



Date: 17th November, 2023: The department initiated a lecture series from eminent subject experts to sensitize our students concerning current research. In this regard, on November 17th, 2023 a lecture on the topic entitled "Sensing Climate Change Indicators from Space with special emphasis on Forest Ecosystems" was delivered by Dr. C. P. Singh, Scientist F, Space Applications Centre (SAC-ISRO), Ahmedabad, through online mode.

The program started with the welcome remarks of The Head of the Department. The senior professor of the department, Prof. D. Paul, emphasized developing a series of lectures from time to time, which will benefit our students. Prof. M. S. Bisht stated that as per NEP 2020, there is a need to interact with our students with current research going on in the country. More than 70 students of the department along with research scholars present during the lecture.

The students benefited from learning about, how to access climate change through tools and techniques of remote sensing, GIS, and hyperspectral imaging in forest ecosystems. Dr. Singh emphasized that the space-borne technique provides a powerful systematic tool to monitor, map, and model the diverse vegetation cover and give a precise and accurate road map for numerous aspects. The forest research is using remote sensing to improve the reporting of key forest indicators such as woodland loss monitoring, storm damage monitoring, and larch mapping. Further, the data sets and analysis techniques provide scale-specific approaches, in spatial and temporal contexts, for measurement and monitoring ecosystems at the individual, population, community, ecosystem, and biosphere levels. The book compiled the history of the Mizo population that settled in the southeastern part of Shillong city called Happy Valley from the 1960s onwards. During the session, Donoghue and Khongwir shared the profound inspiration behind their collaborative work. "Stories From The Valley" emerged from a tapestry of grief and love, woven during challenging periods in the authors' lives. Distinct from the conventional academic lens, the authors emphasized that the book's essence lies in its dedication to the communities featured in the stories. Rather than merely presenting narratives, the book is a heartfelt gesture meant for these communities.

A noteworthy aspect of the book is its deliberate incorporation of a multilingual narrative. With an interplay of Mizo, English, and Khasi languages, the authors aimed to make the stories more inclusive and relatable to many readers. This diversity in language makes the stories richer and adds depth to the storytelling, allowing readers to connect with them on a more personal level.





To complement the book launch, an exhibition showcased the striking photographs featured in the book. This exhibition provided attendees a chance to really experience the landscape and stories that make "Stories From The Valley" unique and special to the literary world.

Khongwir shared that these visuals were captured through the lens of listening, emphasizing the intimate relationship between the stories and the images.
