Guidelines for Selection of MOOCs

This is for the information of all the students of 2023 Batch that those who are willing to opt for MOOCs in their third semester must follow the following guidelines:

- i) Students should inform the Head in writing about the details of the MOOCs they wish to opt for.
- ii) Students should not switch from one course (DSEC or MOOCs) to another at a later date.
- iii) Students should make sure that they opt for courses with **four credits only**.
- iv) If a student registered for MOOCs wishes to opt for a Departmental DSEC course instead, this change must be made during the registration for the end-semester examination on the NEHU portal. In such cases, students must adhere to NEHU rules and regulations regarding attendance, sessional examinations, etc.,
- v) The students should also submit details regarding their successful completion of MOOCs courses to the department.

The students are advised to consult Dr. Karen L Donoghue, the Departmental Swayam Mentor (DSM) for clarification, if any.
