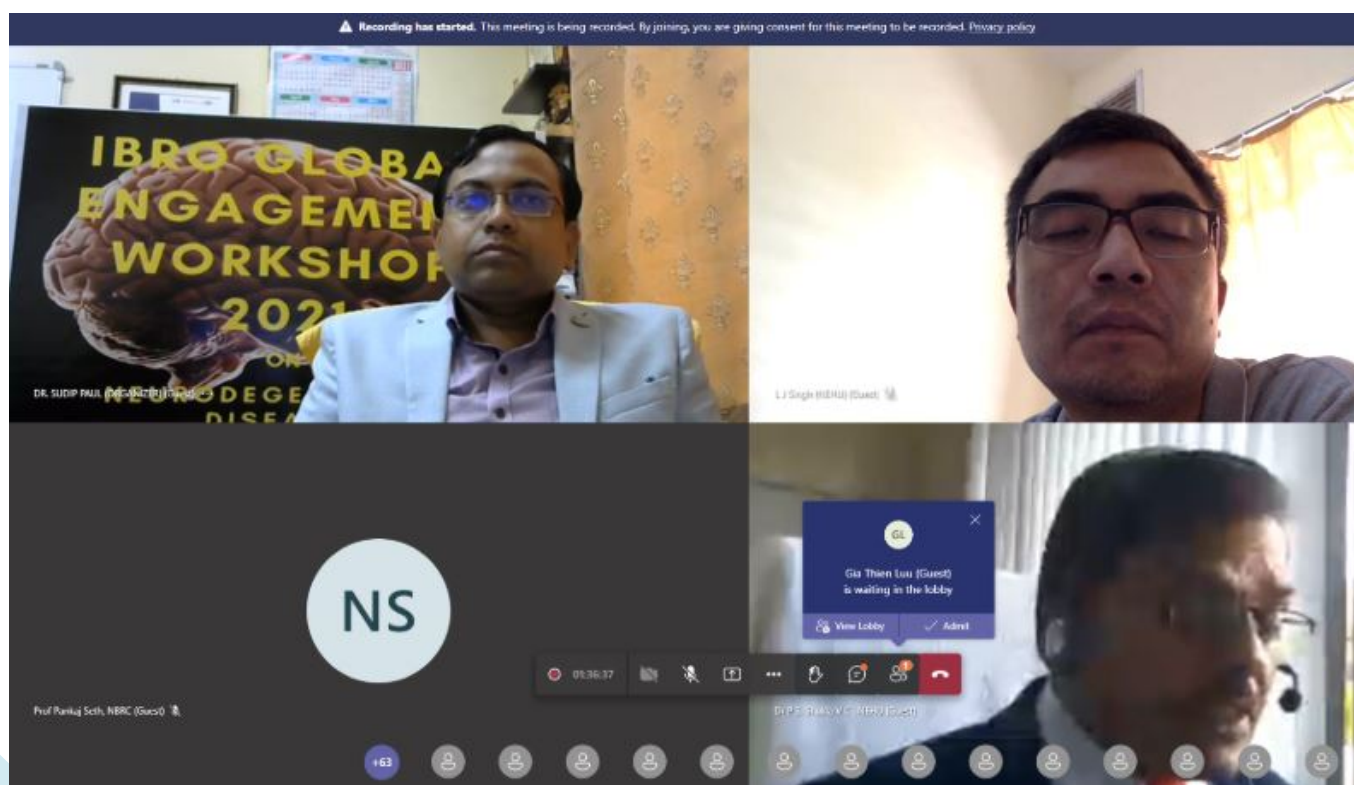
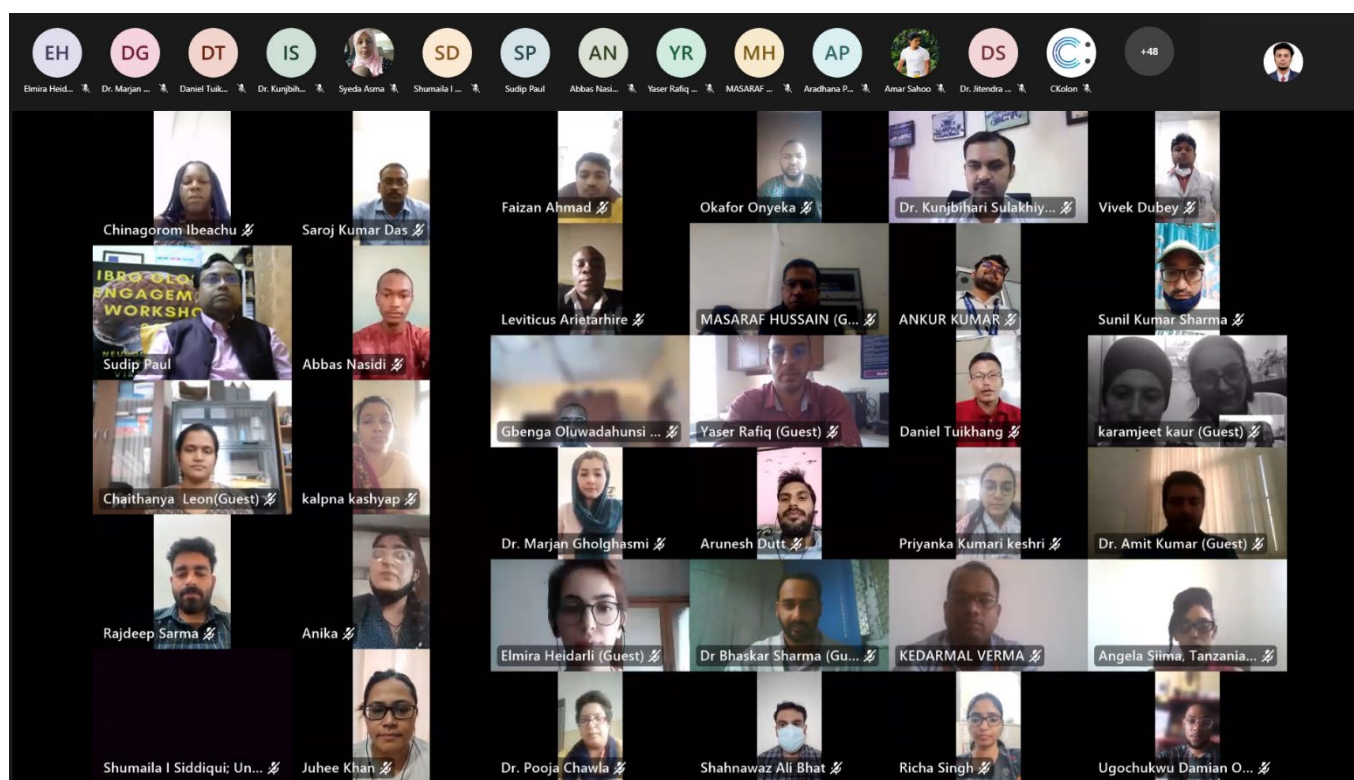

INTERNATIONAL BRAIN RESEARCH ORGANIZATION GLOBAL ENGAGEMENT WORKSHOP 2021 ON “NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASES” during October 1st to 5th, 2021 was held online with technical assistance and support from Microsoft Teams through CKolon, Bengaluru, India, organized by the Dept. of Biomedical Engineering (BME), School of Technology (SoT), North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong under the overall supervision of Dr. Sudip Paul, Asstt. Professor & Workshop Coordinator, Dept. of BME and other faculty members, research scholars, and staff. The event was inaugurated on October 1st, 2021, with the inaugural address by the Honorable Vice-Chancellor of NEHU, Prof. Prabha Shankar Shukla, and a brief speech by the Dean, SoT, NEHU, Prof. L. In addition to this, 18 speaker sessions were also conducted from across the world. The workshop concluded with a valedictory session on October 5th, 2021. The event was financially supported by International Brain Research Organization (IBRO).
