Participants

- Ph.D. in Law

Essay Marking Parameters

All entries shall be evaluated on the basis of following criteria:

• Knowledge of the topic

- Originality of content
- Creativity
- Quality of research
- Coherency and clarity of expression

All essays shall be evaluated anonymously.

<u>Jury</u>

All essays shall be evaluated by a distinguished panel of Judges and Academicians. The decision of the Jury shall be final and binding.

Submission Guidelines

- The essay must be written in English only.
- A participant can submit only one essay. Multiple or incomplete submissions will lead to disqualification.
- Co-authorship is not allowed.
- The essay should not be more than 3500 words (including footnotes and an abstract of not more than 200 words.
- Footnotes must conform to the Oxford University Standard for Citation of Legal Authorities (OSCOLA) format. OSCOLA can be accessed at <<u>http://www.law.ox.ac.uk/publications/oscola.php</u>>.
- The essay must contain a cover-page with the following details:
 - Name of the participant
 - Course of study (including year and semester)
 - o Name of the institution affiliated with

- o Contact number of the participant
- The essay must be submitted in the following format:

Line Spacing	1.5 for main text and 1 for footnotes
Paragraph Spacing	Auto (both before and after)
File Format	Word document (doc./docx)
File Name	Name of the partcipant
