COURSE STRUCTURE OF Ph. D. COURSE-WORK

The Ph. D. course-work shall comprise of three (3) compulsory courses. The duration of the Ph. D. coursework is one semester where student must have to earn total of 12 credits. Each course comprises of four (4) units of equal weightage, i.e. one (1) credit, 12 contact hours and equivalent to 25 marks. Therefore, each course shall require a minimum of 48 contact hours spread over the semester and each course will be evaluated for maximum of 100 marks. For every paper the weightage of continuous evaluation marks and end semester exam shall be 25% and 75% respectively. The break-up of courses to be offered shall be as follows:
